


Single Verse Method


I'm so glad you were free for lunch. How has your week been....

Me too... I' ve had a rough week, things just don't seem to be going my way...




I've been doing a lot of reading lately...

I've read some but not the whole thing...




Did it make sense? With all those names and stuff it's kinda confusing.

Some made sense but there is just so much....




What would you think if I could explain the entire Bible in about 10 minutes

How can you do that???




Have you ever heard of "John 3:16"? Its probably the most famous verse...



Sin caused separation between God and man








Now that would be unpleasant!!!





That's where I want to be!








People have tried so many things to get right with God.


They give money, work hard, go to church, act good...

Only Jesus can bridge the gap between man and God






LINE #4 ~~ MAN'S RESPONSE

God loves us, sin separated us from God, and Jesus' life and death has paid for our sins.







Its as easy as the verse. If you would like to trust Christ you can do it right now in 4 steps.

- 1. Thank God for his love
- 2. Tell Him you are sorry for your sins
- 3. Thank Him for sending Jesus to forgive you
- 4. And declare you believe in Christ and want Him to make things right in your life. (submit to Christ)

If you are sincere and really mean these things, Christ will reestablish your relationship with God.


